DEAR is an EU program, that



European Year for Development

The European Year for Development 2015 (EYD2015), flagship initiative of the EU for 2015, aims at raising the awareness of citizens on development issues, informing them how the European Union is acting to the EU with regards to development. It also intends to promote citizens' engagement for development by encouraging, by contributing/sponsoring to NGOs and other actors, taking more reflective actions on a daily basis, becoming more active citizens at local, national and global levels.

LADDER is a 3 year project on Development education, raising raising awareness of citizens about development issues. In that sense, it supports the efforts to engage citizens in development, to raise their awareness and promote active thinking. ALDA and its LADDER partners are working on that direction, promoting the EYD2015. In addition, a Thematic Day of LADDER is dedicated to the EYD2015, under which the representatives of the co-projects and associates are meeting together to promote the EYD2015.
